When would you use a roll-off container?

A roll-off is a temporary container and is referred to as "roll-off" because the container itself is typically configured with small wheels, and the vehicle used to deliver and pick up the container uses a hoist and a tipping bed to roll the container on and off at each site.

Liberty County Solid Waste Authority will provide roll-off service to commercial and residential customers in Liberty County.



Typically, a roll-off container would be used for waste from building construction, such as lumber, shingles, building materials, limited amounts of rocks, brick or concrete, or other trash resulting from construction or major remodeling or resulting from a general cleanup of vacant or improved property.


A service fee of \$87.55 is incurred each time the container is pulled for disposal.

Disposal fee of \$41.91 per ton is charged based on scaled weight at Liberty County transfer station.

Other services offered:

- ♦ Front-Load Commercial Dumpsters
- ♦ Cardboard Collection Dumpsters
- ♦ Office Recycling Program
- ♦ Bulk Waste Disposal at Transfer Station







A service agreement is required.

Roll-off trucks must have 50 feet of straight clear access to approach and engage the container. All container sites must have minimum height clearance of 25 feet.

It is the customer's responsibility to provide an accessible location for the container.

Maximum permissible load, including the container, is 15 ton (30,000 pounds).

Customers will assume responsibility for damage to or loss of the rented container(s).
