BUILDING SERVICE/GROUNDS WORKER **Building Maintenance**

The Liberty County Board of Commissioners is currently accepting applications for the position of **Building Service/Grounds Worker** within the Building Maintenance Department. Applicants must have knowledge of building maintenance methods and practices and have skill in operating buffers, shampoo machines, and vacuum cleaners. Skill in operating grounds maintenance equipment and tools is a plus. Successful applicants must possess and maintain a current Georgia driver's license.

The Building Service/Grounds Worker is responsible for performing a variety of custodial duties such as cleaning, sanitizing restrooms, sweeping, mopping, waxing and buffing floors. Additional duties include changing light bulbs, picking up trash, and emptying trash containers on a regular basis to keep assigned buildings neat and clean. This position also mows grass, cleans lawns and parking lots, waters grass, and plants and maintains lawns and flowers. This position requires the ability to move furniture, supplies, and boxes, and be able to lift and/or carry weights of forty (40) to seventy (70) pounds.
