

ATTENTION WATER CUSTOMERS:

The State of Georgia Environmental Protection Division has implemented, effective immediately, Level 1 Drought Restrictions for all water customers on the [Liberty County Water System](#).

Below, is a list of items to help minimize wasteful water use, and to promote an overall awareness to water conservation:

- ❖ Water lawns and outdoor plants only between 4PM and 10AM.
- ❖ Reducing your shower by 2 minutes will save 5 gallons per shower.
- ❖ Turn off the water while you shave or brush your teeth. This can save at least 100 gallons a week.
- ❖ Check your toilets for leaks. If leaking, please address and repair immediately. Just one leaking toilet flapper can use in excess of 30,000 gallons a month.
- ❖ Scrape your dishes instead of rinsing before placing in the dishwasher. This could save 6 gallons a day.
- ❖ Limit dishwashing to FULL loads and you can save at least 2 gallons a load.
- ❖ Repair any leaky faucets as soon as you notice them. A leak of 60 drops a minute wastes 192 gallons a month.
- ❖ Do only FULL loads of laundry. Cutting back to one load of laundry can save up to 45 gallons per load
