

**NOTICE OF ELECTION POSTPONEMENT
AND EXTENDED VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE**

AT THE DIRECTION OF THE OFFICE OF THE GEORGIA SECRETARY OF STATE, AND IN RESPONSE TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY POSED BY THE CORONAVIRUS, THE MARCH 24 PRESIDENTIAL PREFERENCE PRIMARY AND TSPLOST SPECIAL ELECTION (collectively, the “March Elections”), HAVE BEEN RESCHEDULED TO COINCIDE WITH THE MAY 19, 2020 STATEWIDE GENERAL PRIMARY ELECTION. POLLS WILL NOT BE OPEN ON MARCH 24, 2020.

Effective March 15, 2020, all in-person voting for the March Elections has been suspended. However, ballots that have already been cast for the March Elections will be counted. All persons who have not voted in the March Elections will be able to vote in both the March Elections and the General Primary Election using specially prepared ballots for use in connection with the May 19, 2020 elections. Advance in-person (early) voting for the March Elections will resume on April 27, 2020 to coincide with the General Primary Election. Absentee by mail ballots will be available on March 31, 2020 for use in both the March Elections and General Primary Election. Additionally, all absentee by mail ballots for the March Elections which are timely returned in accordance with the original election schedule for said March Elections will be processed in accordance with Georgia law.

Any person who registers up until the April 20, 2020 voter registration deadline for the May 19, 2020 General Primary Election will be eligible to vote in both the March Elections and the General Primary Election.
