On March 13, 2020, Chief Justice Harold D. Melton of the Georgia Supreme Court signed an Order Declaring a Statewide Judicial Emergency. As per the Order at that time the Magistrate Court halted all hearings with the exception of emergency actions or procedures. Subsequent extensions of the Statewide Order authorized Courts to conduct virtual and in-person hearings as long as Public Health and CDC guidelines were being followed. On November 9, 2020, Georgia Supreme Court Chief Justice Harold D. Melton signed an Eighth Order, extending his Order declaring a Statewide Judicial Emergency until Wednesday, December 9, 2020, at 11:59 p.m.

We have established a safety protocol in order to resume most court activities. We have addressed dispossessories and garnishments filed before March 13th first. The remainder of the general civil calendar and criminal calendar have resumed on a case-by-case basis after considering the particular circumstances of each case.

We have resumed in person court activities by appointment only. Please call our office so we can determine whether your matter can be resolved over the telephone or whether you need to set up an appointment to come into our office.

We ask that you remain patient with us as we continue to adjust to this new norm.
